The purposes of the meeting are to review existing proxy voting procedures and, if time permits, to discuss non-proxy corporate communications practices.

- \* Commissioner Longstreth will be the luncheon speaker at a meeting of the National Association of Manufacturers in Denver, Colorado. He will speak on the topic of the SEC's regulation of shareholder proposals.

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### STIX & CO. INC. ENJOINED; PERMANENT TRUSTEE APPOINTED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on November 5 a complaint was filed in the Eastern District of Missouri seeking to temporarily restrain and preliminarily and permanently enjoin Stix & Co. Inc. from further violations of the net capital, customer reserve, bookkeeping and antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The complaint also sought the appointment of a temporary receiver pending a determination as to whether a trustee should be appointed pursuant to the provisions of the Securities Investor Protection Act (SIPA).

On November 5 a temporary restraining order was issued by the Honorable Kenneth Wangelin and a temporary receiver was appointed. On November 9, after an evidentiary hearing, the Honorable Wangelin appointed a permanent trustee pursuant to the provisions of SIPA and issued an order of preliminary injunction enjoining Stix & Co. from the violations alleged in the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. Stix & Co. Inc., E.D. Mo., Civil Action No. 81-1402-C). (LR-9517)

The Denver Regional Office announced that on November 27 U.S. District Judge Richard P. Matsch of the District of Colorado issued a final judgment of permanent injunction against Alpha Energy & Gold, a Utah corporation with headquarters in Ouray, Colorado, Thomas E. Baumgardner of Ridgeway, Colorado, George I. Lawrence on Montrose, Colorado, and Arnold Winter of Guyman, Oklahoma. Alpha, Baumgardner and Lawrence were enjoined from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws while Winter was enjoined from future violations of the registration provisions of the securities laws. The defendants consented to the entry of the order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint.

Previously, on November 24, the Commission filed a complaint against Alpha, Baumgardner, Lawrence, Winter, Blaine Taylor of Salt Lake City, Utah and D. C. Linton, also of Salt Lake City, in which it was alleged that Alpha, Baumgardner, Lawrence and Taylor violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and that Winter and Linton violated the registration provisions of the securities laws in connection with transactions in the common stock of Alpha.

The complaint, in general, alleges that false and misleading information was distributed to the public concerning the extent and value of Alpha's mining operations and also that a false and misleading Form 10 was filed with the Commission. The injunction also ordered Alpha to correct its Form 10 filing.

No date has been set on the Commission's motion for a preliminary injunction against the remaining defendants Taylor and Linton. (SEC v. Alpha Energy & Gold, U.S.D.C. Colo., Civil Action No. 81-M-2039). (LR-9520)

### THE VARIABLE ANNUITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY
